Purpose

FET

Learning

In the instance of this document, the term 'learning' refers to the end user's reception, processing and ultimate experience of any formal pedagogic activity associated with WWETB's provision of further education and training with which they have participated in.

4. Policy Statement

Waterford and Wexford Education and Training Board (WWETB) commits to providing highquality teaching and learning experiences to suit learners with a wide array of abilities and educational goals.
