# What is an Apprenticeship course?



An apprenticeship combines learning in an education and training institution with work-based learning in a company. At least 50% of apprenticeship learning is completed in the workplace. Apprenticeships lead to nationally recognised qualifications.

Apprentices 'earn while they learn' – they have an employment contract and are paid a salary for the duration of their apprenticeship training.

Apprenticeships vary in length depending on the programme, lasting between two and four years.

### What is a Traineeship course



Traineeships are courses that combine training with WWETB and on-the-job work experience. A traineeship is shorter than an apprenticeship.

WWETB is running a Welding Fabrication traineeship, a full-time course that will run for 31 weeks (21 weeks training and 10 weeks work experience). The aim of this course is to provide learners with the skills and related knowledge in fabrication - basic skills, manual metal arc welding,

oxy-acetylene welding and MIG/TIG welding.

## What is a Post Leaving Cert (PLC) course?



These are full-time, one-year QQI level 5 courses for people who have completed their Leaving Certificate (or other equivalent) and adults returning to education.

PLC courses aim to develop technical and practical skills for an industry-recognised qualification while also offering a route to higher education.


### What is ESOL?
